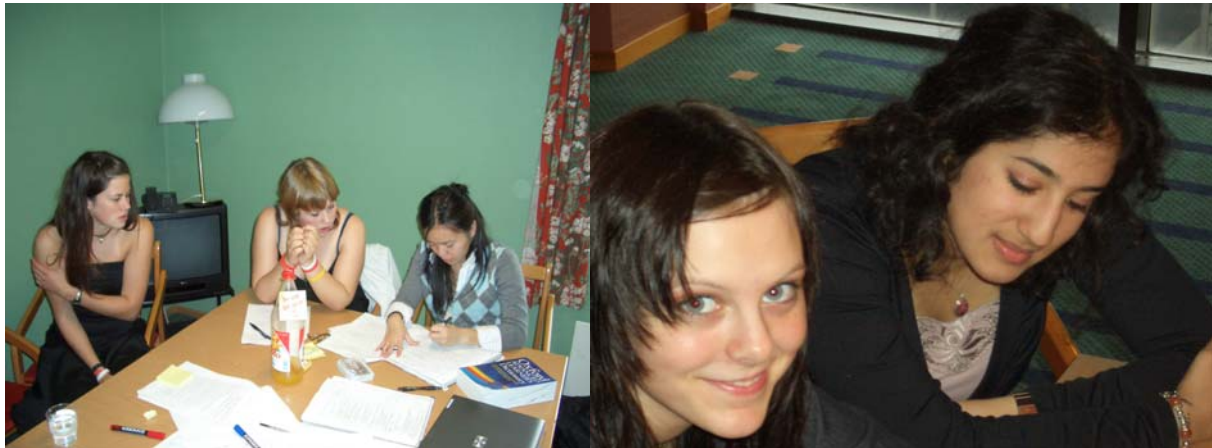

This will also support the Karsk and Snus multinational corporation, The Karsk&Snus association, Scandinavia's most important employer in the production of healthy diseases.

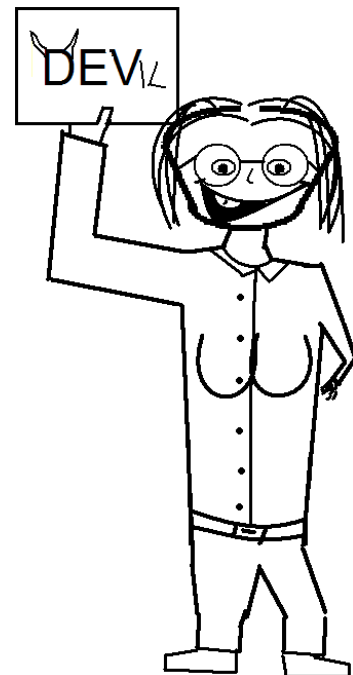

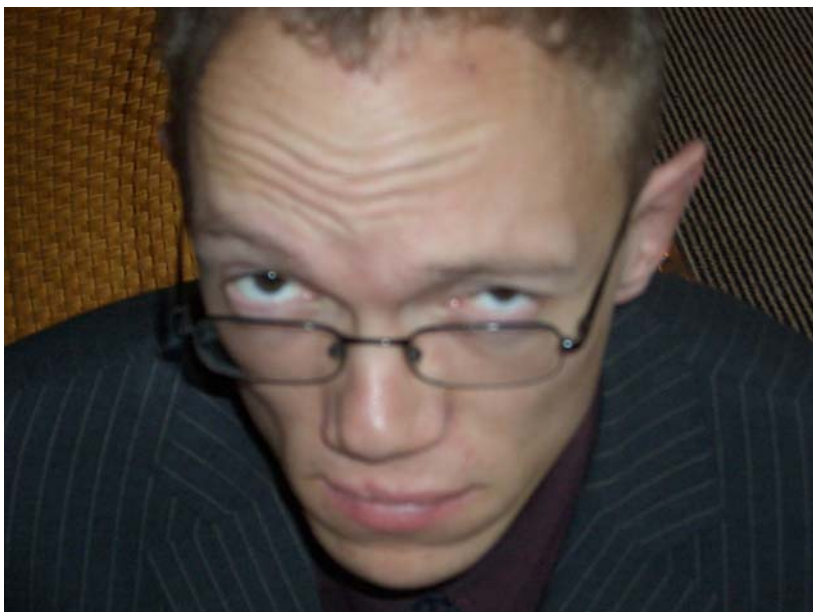
